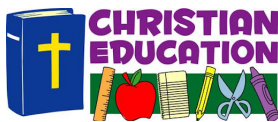

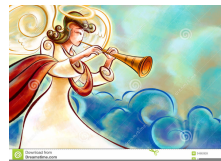

Ms. Mary Alice McKeinze, sister of Anne Randall, died on September 28, 2021, in Notasulga, AL.

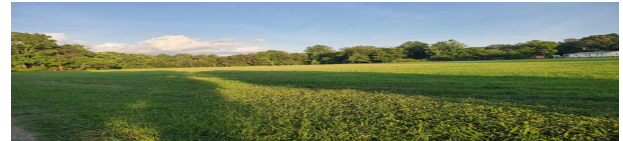
WHO REMEMBERS THIS??

Jones, native of New Kent County, son of the late William and Bettie Richards Jones, who died Saturday, June 4, at his residence in Croaker, will be held Thursday, June 10, at 1:30 P. M. Body will lie in state at St. John Baptist Church from 10:30 A. M., Thursday, until hour of funeral and interment will follow in the church cemetery. Rev. M. C. Holland, a former Williamsburg pastor, will officiate, assisted by other clergymen. Rev. Jones had served in James City County approximately 28 years as pastor of Shiloh and St. John Baptist Churches.
